

WHEN AND HOW TO REPORT CORONAVIRUS SYMPTOMS

With the recent emergence of Covid-19, we are working to ensure that information being disseminated is factual and that all of the children and families we support are safe.

Here is information you need if you, or someone in your home, are experiencing symptoms associated with Coronavirus:

REPORTING SYMPTOMS

If you are experiencing symptoms - such as fever, cough or shortness of breath - please call your Primary Care Provider or the Florida Health Department's Covid-19 hotline at <u>1-866-779-6121</u>. It is important that you contact your Primary Care Provider or Dept. of Health before calling or going to an ER.

If this is an emergency, call your nearest Emergency Room to be screened, or call <u>911</u>.

TESTING SITES

With an order from a Primary Care provider, you may receive a test at any Centra Care Clinic, Quest Lab or Lab Corp in our tri-county region. Please call ahead for an appointment.

Additionally, starting March 25, 2020, a test site will operate at the Orange County Convention Center, <u>9400</u> <u>Universal Blvd, Orlando FL, 32819</u>. A doctor's order will also be required to receive testing at this site

UNDERLYING CONDITIONS

Individuals with underlying conditions should be considered particularly high risk for Covid-19. Following CDC guidelines, the following criteria are considered underlying conditions:

- chronic lung disease; moderate to severe asthma

- immunocompromised, including cancer treatment

- heart disease

- organ transplant patients
- immune deficiencies
 HIV/AIDS

- diabetes
- renal or liver disease

- prolonged use of corticosteroids such as steroid inhalers, and oral medications such as prednisone

- pregnancy
